## Replacing a Commission representative:

- Any Commission representative leaving their post should notify CT Humanities and the Commission Chair as soon as possible to establish a succession plan for Commission membership.
  - Only Members of the Public must go through a confirmation process with the Director of Appointments in the Office of the Governor.
- When a Commission representative leaves their post but is not immediately replaced, they can designate a person from their department / organization to serve on the Commission until their replacement is confirmed. At the time of confirmation, that person can elect to either serve on the Commission or designate someone else.
- When a Commission representative leaves their post with a successor in place, the successor will be invited to serve on the Commission or to designate someone else in their place.
- Commission members are encouraged to consider the IDEA vision and values statement when selecting their replacement or designee to ensure representation of many backgrounds and beliefs.
