1. Minutes Approval

2. Updates

- a. Regional 250 Planners Conference

Arienne Orozco provided an update from the Northeast Regional 250 Planners convening in Newport, RI on June 2. Rhode Island's commission now has a marketing company working with them. Other states are also looking to expand the 250th beyond 2026, for varying lengths of time. The Newport History Museum spoke about their fundraising efforts and said they have had a relatively easy time to raise money - that there is bipartisan support and there is a lot of emotion and nostalgia generated from talking about the ideals & imagery of the revolution. A representative from the Youth 250 Bureau also spoke; this group could be a good resource for organizations which want to engage with youth but don't have the capacity on their own. Other states would like to collaborate on additional events - particularly, Vermont would like to work with Connecticut on a project associated with Ethan Allen. The group is looking for a state to host the 2026 convening - Cyndi Tolosa agreed to consider sites to partner with to potentially host in Connecticut, possibly either in Mystic or Ridgefield.
