It was noted that many libraries applied this month; CTH staff held an information session with the Connecticut Library Association and commission member Margaret Khan on October 1, and many attendees applied.

3. Commission Meeting - October 15, 2025

Arienne Orozco opened conversation on plans for the commission meeting on 10/15. The Governance subcommittee update will include a reminder of the Annual Report to the Governor (due in January 2026). It will also include an update on the current number of affiliates (roughly 150) and encouragement to continue to share the affiliate program amongst their networks.

Jason Mancini recommended highlighting our goal of 250 affiliate organizations by the 250th to inspire participation.

There was also discussion of the Secretary of the States' race/gender polling. This commission is not required to submit to the SOTS office. R. Gonzalez noted that the makeup of the commission and its subcommittees has not changed much, if at all, since the polling completed in 2024. J. Mancini requested that polling be conducted regardless to document. A. Orozco noted that the SOTS survey has not updated the terminology on its survey, so the language on the commission's survey can reflect that.
