CTH will provide affiliate organizations with \$500 to support programs, events, and initiatives to help commemorate the 250th in communities across the state.

Eligibility:

- All America 250 | CT Affiliate organizations are eligible, unless they are receiving an America 250 | CT Municipal Stipend.
- Affiliate organizations must plan some kind of public programming (examples include public readings of the Declaration of Independence, exhibitions, performances, lectures, public programs, or walking tours) and share that program with the America 250 | CT Commission for promotion on CT Visit.

- Applications will be accepted through Sunday, June 28, 2026, at 11:59pm.
- Award notifications are expected to be made weekly beginning Monday, May 18, 2026 through Monday, June 29, 2026.
